I write to you as Chief Privacy Officer of <u>Jumbo Privacy</u>. We are a company that is premised on the philosophy that privacy of our users, and users we represent as authorized agent, is paramount.

It has come to our attention that the mobile application "<u>Care19</u>" is sharing data of its users to third parties, notably to Foursquare, without disclosing such sharing in its privacy policy. In particular, Care 19 shares with Foursquare the following information:

- IDFA
- · Lat, long to reverse geolocation
- "a userId" (which matches the app anonymous ID)

We are concerned for users that might be using Care 19, this is why we would like to understand what Foursquare is doing with such information. Could you please indicate to us if Foursquare is:

- storing the data shared by Care19 in a database? If so, for what duration and for what purposes?
- using the data shared by Care19 for advertising purposes, in particular by using the collected IDFAs?

In addition, can you please reply to these questions:

- For what purpose Foursquare is receiving "anonymous ID" of the Care 19 users'?
- · If a person makes a data request to Foursquare, by submitting his/her IDFA through <u>Foursquare's online form</u>, when complying with such request, will Foursquare include the IDFA of such person received through Care 19?
